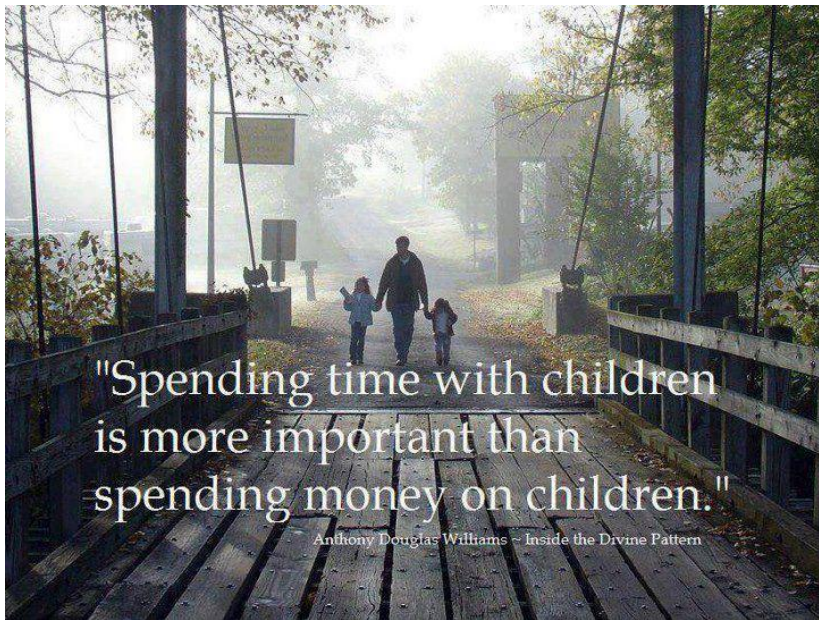


Pictured above are Ann Horine and Pat Henry ready for graduation parties and activities.
