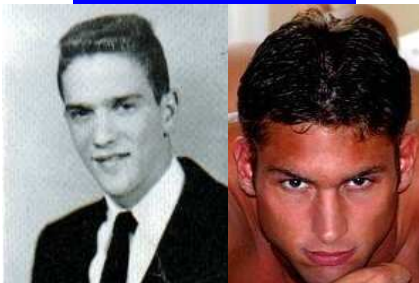

RECIPE CORNER

Scalloped Pineapple

This recipe is great with baked ham and sweet potatoes.

1 large can pineapple chunks or tidbits (well drained)

3 eggs

4 cups bread cubes

1 ½ cups sugar

¾ cup melted margarine – cooled

1 can evaporated milk

Beat eggs, and add sugar. Add melted & cooled margarine and evaporated milk. Blend together; add pineapple and bread cubes. Mix well. Pour into baking dish greased with butter. Bake 350 degrees for 30 minutes or until light golden brown.

Venison Barbecue

Soak 2-3 lbs. of venison overnight in 1-cup vinegar, 1-cup water, and 1/4-cup salt. Cook meat in pressure cooker with 1-cup water & 1 can beer for 40 minutes at 10 lbs. of pressure.

Remove meat and pull apart.

Place meat in crock-pot and add:

2 medium onions finely chopped

2-3 tbsp. Worcestershire sauce

1/2-cup brown sugar

1/2-cup ketchup

1 – 12 oz. bottle barbecue sauce

Salt & pepper to taste

Optional – Texas Pete or Louisiana hot sauce to taste. Cook on low for 1 to 2 hrs.

Venison Chili

2 to 3 lbs. ground venison – browned

1 can pinto beans

2 cans black beans

1 med. red onion

1 (26oz.) can spaghetti sauce (garlic & onion)

1 can diced tomatoes

1 green pepper

2 stalks celery (chopped)

2 cloves garlic or garlic powder

2 beef bouillon cubes

1tsp. Paprika

2 tsp chili powder

1tsp salt

1tsp black pepper

1 jalapeño pepper or hot chili sauce to your taste

5 cups of water

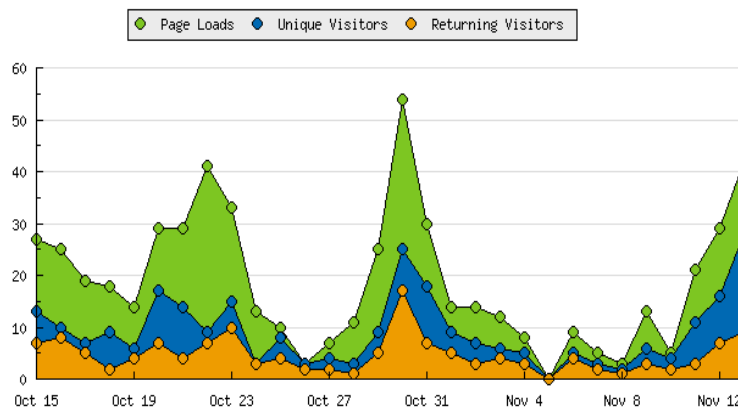

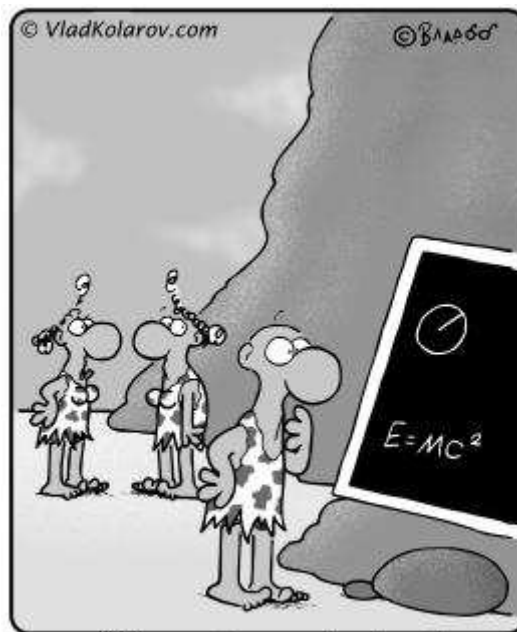
DOWN AT THE RETIREMENT CENTER
