BECAUSE IT MEANS I AM CAPABLE OF WALKING


AND I HAVE BEEN BLESSED WITH TRANSPORTATION .

BECAUSE IT MEANS I HAVE CLOTHES TO WEAR.


FOR WEARINESS AND ACHING MUSCLES AT THE END OF THE DAY
