

This beautiful heiress from a wealthy family named the Vlachs of Albania was Agnes Boiagiu π but she became...










This mischievous schoolboy, considered "stupid, restless, inquisitive, asking too many questions and a slow learner, " is...



Thomas Edison inventor of the incandescent bulb and many other devices



This lawyer from an aristocratic British family, was in fact Indian and fights for his country's independence using pacifism , is...




Mohandas Gandhi



This young pioneer was hated and considered a cockroach by his classmates, is...






Nicolas Sarkozy French President
