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In winter why do we try to keep the house as warm as it was in summer when we complained about the heat?

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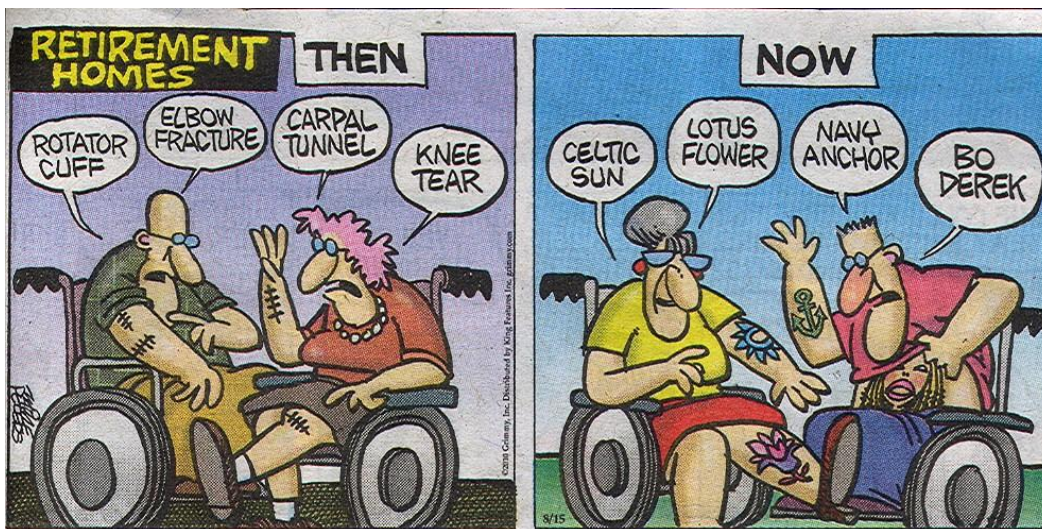
How come you never hear father-in-law jokes?
